



## **Hucknall Warriors FC** **Code of conduct**

Hucknall Warriors FC wants to have a reputation as a team with disciplined players, managers, coaches and spectators. These rules apply to you and will help our club achieve the above. This code of conduct applies in conjunction with the clubs constitution. Hucknall Warriors want to be known as a club who promote fair play, equality, professional conduct (of all) and respect for fellow players and spectators. The following is what is expected from all parties associated with the football club. The code of conduct should be promoted by managers, coaches, players and parents alike. Specifically the following should be followed:

### **Managers and coaches:**

1. All managers and coaches will at all times act in the best interests of the membership.
2. All managers and coaches will ensure that the code of conduct as it applies to players is monitored and fulfilled by all players in their respective teams.
3. All managers and coaches will represent the club in all manners as laid down in both this code of conduct and the clubs constitution.
4. Promote fair play and respect amongst all players.
5. Ensure the Clubs expectations are met with regards to this code of conduct and the clubs constitution as a whole.

### **Players:**

1. Never foul with intent.
2. The referee's decision is final.
3. Respect and support your fellow team players.
4. Respect the opposition's players.
5. Always shake hands at the end of a game.
6. Always apologise to the opposing player where you commit a foul.
7. Wear Warriors clothing as appropriate for both matches and training.
8. Respect your Warriors clothing.
9. Do not wear jewellery during training or matches.
10. Respect the equipment provided by the club.
11. Respect the facilities of the oppositions ground.
12. Do not use foul or abusive language.
13. Remember you/your guardians are responsible for any fines during matches.
14. Do NOT wear Warriors clothing other than for matches and or training.

### **Parents & spectators:**

1. Ensure players comply with this code of conduct.
2. The referee's decision is final and should not be questioned.
3. Respect the opposition's players, coaches and spectators.
4. Do not use foul or abusive language.
5. Stand at least one metre from the touchline during matches.
